2	AN ACT TO CLARIFY RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CITY OF
3	LINCOLNTON SEAT ON THE LINCOLN COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 876 of the 1973 Session Laws reads as
6	rewritten:
7	"Sec. 3. The newly constituted and established Lincoln County Board of Education
8	shall consist of seven members, and each of said members shall be residents and
9	qualified voters of the townships of the districts according to the membership
10	allocations hereinafter made to said townships as follows:
11	(1) North Brook Township,
12	(2) The area of Howard's Creek Township, Township outside the city
13	limits of Lincolnton,
14	(3) that The area of Lincolnton Township presently outside the present
15	city limits of Lincolnton,
16	(4) that <u>The</u> area of <u>Lincolnton Township presently</u> inside the city limits
17	of Lincolnton,
18	(5) <u>The area of Ironton Township, Township outside the city limits of</u>
19	Lincolnton, and
20	(6) Catawba Springs <u>Township.</u>
21	Each district shall each be entitled to one member on the Lincoln County Board of
22	Education. For the purpose of this section, the city limits of the City of Lincolnton are
23	as of the opening of candidate filing.
24	One member shall be elected from the county at large, without regard to township."
25	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
