1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE NET PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF TIMBER AT SAMARKAND YOUTH ACADEMY TO BE USED FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND REPAIRS AND RENOVATIONS AT THE ACADEMY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The Department of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention shall harvest and sell a portion of the timber on the real property at Samarkand Youth Academy. Notwithstanding Chapter 146 of the General Statutes, G.S. 66-58, and any other provision of law, the net proceeds derived from the sale of the timber in an amount not to exceed two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) shall be deposited with the State Treasurer in a capital improvement and repair and renovation account to the credit of the Department of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention. The Department shall use the funds for major repair to the streets and parking lots at the Samarkand Youth Academy and for additional street lighting and repairs of buildings at the Academy.

The remainder of the net proceeds from the sale of the timber at Samarkand Youth Academy, if any, shall revert to the General Fund.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
