(Public) Short Title: Presidential Elector Challenge. Representatives Goodwin; Dedmon, Insko, and Wainwright. Sponsors: Referred to: Election Law and Campaign Finance Reform. February 1, 2001 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR SELECTION OF PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IF THE ELECTION RESULTS HAVE NOT BEEN CERTIFIED BY THE DATE PROVIDED BY FEDERAL LAW. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 18 of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 163-213. Selection of Presidential Electors by General Assembly in certain circumstances. As permitted by 3 U.S.C. § 2, whenever the election of Presidential Electors has not been certified under G.S. 163-210 prior to the date for settling controversies specified by 3 U.S.C. § 5, the General Assembly may select Presidential Electors." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
