The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-15(a) reads as rewritten:	
"(a) The board of trustees of any institution organized under this C	
with the prior approval of the North Carolina Community Colleges Sys	
convey a right-of-way or easement for highway construction or for utility	
or modifications. When in the opinion of the board of trustees of any	
organized under this Chapter, the use of any other real or personal proper	
held by the board of trustees is unnecessary or undesirable for the purp	
institution, the board of trustees, subject to prior approval of the Stat	
Community Colleges, may sell, exchange, or lease the property in the same	
provided by law for the sale, exchange, or lease of school property by co	
boards of education or in accordance with G.S. 160A 274. property. T	he board of
trustees may dispose of any personal property owned or held by the board	d of trustees
without approval of the State Board of Community Colleges.	
Article 12 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes shall apply to the dis	posal or sale
of any real or personal property under this subsection. Personal property	also may be
disposed of under procedures adopted by the North Carolina Dep	oartment of
Administration. The proceeds of any sale or lease shall be used for ca	ipital outlay
purposes, except as provided in subsection (b) of this section."	

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
