SECTION 1. Article 4 of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 20-196.4. Reimbursement for services at events conducted by private organizations.

- (a) The Department of Crime Control and Public Safety shall calculate the total costs of traffic control and other ancillary services provided by the State Highway Patrol at events conducted or sponsored by private organizations.
- (b) The private organization shall pay to the State one-half of the costs as determined pursuant to subsection (a) of this section. Funds received under this subsection shall be credited to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety to pay for the services provided by the State Highway Patrol.
- (c) This section does not apply to any event conducted or sponsored by a State agency."
 - **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
