A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AT CLUB
2 NOVA, A MENTAL HEALTH FACILITY IN THE TOWN OF CARRBORO.

3 Whereas, Club Nova is a psychiatric rehabilitation program run by the OPC
4 Foundation for Mental Health, Inc., in Orange County; and

5 Whereas, Club Nova serves adults who have been diagnosed with a serious
6 mental illness; and

7 Whereas, Club Nova offers members assistance with housing, education, job
8 training, employment, and daily living skills; and

9 Whereas, Club Nova serves 36 to 42 members per day; and

10 Whereas, Club Nova's facility was purchased in 1991 to house 11 members in
11 adjacent apartments and to provide space for the clubhouse program; and

12 Whereas, the facility was built in the 1920s and is in serious need of repairs,
13 renovation, and expansion to adequately serve those needing Club Nova's services;

14 Now, therefore,

15 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

16 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to OPC
17 Foundation for Mental Health, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of one hundred
18 thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year for repairs and renovation of
19 the Club Nova, a mental health facility in the Town of Carrboro.

20 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
