A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT ADDING CERTAIN DESCRIBED PROPERTY TO THE CORPORATE
3 LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF NAVASSA.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** The following described property is added to the corporate
6 limits of the Town of Navassa:

7 Beginning at a point where the existing Town limits intersect at Mill Creek and Joe's
8 Slough; thence from the Beginning in a northwest direction approximately 7000 feet ±
9 with the run of Mill Creek to SR 1432 – Old Mill Road; thence in a northwardly
10 direction with the run of Rowel Branch a scaled distance of 7800 feet ± to the
11 intersection of SR 1426 – Mt. Misery Road; thence with the centerline of SR 1426 – Mt.
12 Misery Road in a northwardly direction to the property line intersection of E. I. Dupont
13 Denemours & Co. (Map Book 8, Page 74); thence with Dupont eastern property line in
14 a northeast direction a scale distance of 11,800 feet ± to the Brunswick County line in
15 the centerline of the Cape Fear River; thence with the Brunswick County line (Cape
16 Fear River) a southeasterly direction a scaled distance of 57,300 feet ± to the
17 intersection of Cape Fear River and Davis Creek (existing Navassa town limits); thence
18 with Davis Creek (existing Navassa town limits) in a westerly direction a scale distance
19 of 9300 feet ± to Joe's Slough; thence with Joe's Slough in a southerly direction a scaled
20 distance of 7000 feet ± to the Beginning and containing 8300 acres plus or minus as
21 plan meters and scales by G. Douglas Jeffreys, L1432, from a Brunswick County, State
22 of North Carolina Quadrangle Map produced by USGS.

23 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
