1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH TEEN COURT PROGRAMS IN BURKE AND CATAWBA COUNTIES AND TO FUND THE TEEN COURT PROGRAM IN CALDWELL COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention the sum of one hundred five thousand dollars (\$105,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year to establish teen court programs in Burke and Catawba Counties and to fund the teen court program established in Caldwell County. The Department shall allocate thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) for each of the three teen court programs. The teen court programs shall be established and operate pursuant to the guidelines and objectives set forth in Section 40 of Chapter 24 of the Session Laws of the 1994 Extra Session.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
