SECTION 1. G.S. 14-223 reads as rewritten:

(a) If any person shall willfully and unlawfully resist, do	elay or obstruct
physically resist a public officer in discharging or attempting to discharging	arge a duty of his
or her office, he the person shall be guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor.	
(b) If any person shall willfully and unlawfully delay or obstruc	t a public officer
in discharging or attempting to discharge a duty of his or her office, th	e person shall be
guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 200	1, and applies to
offenses committed on or after that date.
