5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 14-223 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 14-223. Resisting officers: delay or obstruct officer in discharge of
8	official duty.
9	(a) If any person shall willfully and unlawfully resist, delay or obstruct
10	physically resist a public officer in discharging or attempting to discharge a duty of his
11	or her office, he the person shall be guilty of a Class 21 misdemeanor.
12	(b) If any person shall willfully and unlawfully delay or obstruct a public officer
13	in discharging or attempting to discharge a duty of his or her office, the person shall be
14	guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor."
15	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2001, and applies to
16	offenses committed on or after that date.
