A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL RESOURCES TO 2 3 ERECT A SECOND HISTORICAL MARKER COMMEMORATING AN 4 INDIVIDUAL. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding G.S. 121-4(7), any rule, or other provision of 6 law, the Department of Cultural Resources, Division of Archives and History, shall 7 have the Department of Transportation erect a second historical marker commemorating 8 9 an individual who has been honored previously with a marker provided that the marker 10 is in a location different than the first marker and the information on the second marker is accurate.
