REPORT FILING FEE FOR THIS PURPOSE.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. G.S. 57C-1-22 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"(f) The Secretary of State shall retain six dollars (\$6.00) of each annual report
filing fee paid under this section, but the balance of the fee shall be deposited into the
General Fund. That portion of the fee retained by the Secretary of State shall not revert
to the General Fund, but shall be used for the purpose of notifying limited liability
companies of the annual report requirement and for carrying out the requirements of this
section (processing annual reports that are delivered for filing). Monies received and
spent pursuant to this subsection shall be subject to audit pursuant to the Executive
Budget Act, Article 1 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes."
SECTION 2. G.S. 57C-1-22 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"(f) The Secretary of State shall retain three dollars (\$3.00) of each annual report
filing fee paid under this section, but the balance of the fee shall be deposited into the
General Fund. That portion of the fee retained by the Secretary of State shall not revert
to the General Fund, but shall be used for the purpose of notifying limited liability
companies of the annual report requirement and for carrying out the requirements of this
section (processing annual reports that are delivered for filing). Monies received and
spent pursuant to this subsection shall be subject to audit pursuant to the Executive
Budget Act, Article 1 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes."

SECTION 3. G.S. 57C-2-23(c) reads as rewritten:

"(c) The Secretary of State must notify limited liability companies of the annual report filing requirement. The annual report shall be delivered to the Secretary of State by the fifteenth day of the fourth month following the close of the limited liability company's fiscal April 15th of each year."

SECTION 4. Section 1 of this act is effective when it becomes law and expires on June 30, 2002. Section 2 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2002. Section 3 of this act becomes effective September 1, 2001. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.
