**HOUSE BILL 1401  
RATIFIED BILL**

AN ACT TO PERMIT THE COUNTY OF WILKES TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY AND  
CONVEY IT TO THE STATE FOR USE AS A VISITORS' CENTER/REST  
AREA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** The County of Wilkes has power under general law to acquire real and personal property and convey it to the State under G.S. 160A-274 or other applicable law for use as a Department of Transportation Visitors' Center/Rest Area.

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2004.
