A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND  
HUMAN SERVICES FOR DIABETES CONTROL ACTIVITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2004-2005 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to establish patient care, diabetes control guidelines, and education and support activities, including technical assistance and training materials. These funds may also be used to support a contract to train local nurse and nutrition teams in the care of patients with diabetes, and to match funds provided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for these and other purposes related to diabetes control.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2004.
