A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REPEAL THE SUNSET ON THE DURHAM CITY ADDITIONAL  
2 MUNICIPAL VEHICLE TAX AND CONCERNING THE PURPOSES FOR  
3 WHICH THOSE FUNDS MAY BE EXPENDED.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 4 of S.L. 2003-329 reads as rewritten:

7 "**SECTION 4.** ~~Section 1 of this act is effective when it becomes law and expires one~~  
8 ~~year after that date. The remainder of this~~ This act is effective when it becomes law."

9 **SECTION 2.** Section 3 of S.L. 2003-329 reads as rewritten:

10 "**SECTION 3.** This act applies to the City of Durham only. ~~Any funds generated by~~  
11 ~~a tax of over five dollars (\$5.00) under Section 1 of this act shall be placed into a~~  
12 ~~separate fund for public transportation within the City of Durham and the principal shall~~  
13 ~~not be spent. The interest earned on those funds may be expended by the City of~~  
14 ~~Durham solely for the purpose of public transportation."~~

15 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
