2	AN ACT TO REMOVE THE SUNSET ON THE LAW PROVIDING THAT
3	CERTAIN SECONDARY SUPPLIERS OF ELECTRIC SERVICE MAY
4	FURNISH SERVICE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF A CITY WITH
5	WRITTEN CONSENT FROM THE CITY, ALLOWING THE MEMBERS OF AN
6	ELECTRIC MEMBERSHIP CORPORATION TO VOTE BY PROXY ON
7	DECISIONS TO ENCUMBER CORPORATE PROPERTY OR TO DISSOLVE
8	THE CORPORATION, AND MAKING TECHNICAL CHANGES TO THE LAW
9	REGARDING MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC SERVICE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

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SECTION 1. Section 6 of Chapter 346 of the 1997 Session Laws, as amended by S.L. 1999-111, reads as rewritten:

"**Section 6.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies only to annexations or incorporations that occur on or after the effective date. This act expires on December 31, 2003."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
