A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PERMIT THE USE OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OVER COOK ROAD FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A PRIVATE BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF ELON.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The Department of Transportation may permit private use and encroachment upon the right-of-way of Cook Road in the Town of Elon for the purpose of construction and maintenance of a bridge to provide access for pedestrians and motor vehicles between the eastern and western portions of the campus of the Twin Lakes Center Continuing Care Retirement Community, owned and operated by Lutheran Retirement Ministries of Alamance County, North Carolina, its successors and assigns, which has been divided by the new right-of-way for Cook Road (Department of Transportation Project No. 8.2472002). Locations, plans, and specifications for the pedestrian and vehicular bridge shall be approved by the Department of Transportation. The encroachments shall not unreasonably interfere with or obstruct the public use of Cook Road and are subject to all other Department of Transportation rules, regulations, and conditions for encroachments.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
