A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE
2 SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES FOR BLUE RIDGE PARKWAY
3 FOUNDATION, SURVEYORS, RETIRED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS,
4 ALTERNATIVE FUEL VEHICLES, ZETA PHI BETA SORORITY, BREAST
5 CANCER AWARENESS, AND MOTHERS AGAINST DRUNK DRIVING.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-63(b) reads as rewritten:

9 "(b) Every license plate shall have displayed upon it the registration number
10 assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of the State of North Carolina,
11 which may be abbreviated, and the year number for which it is issued or the date of
12 expiration. A plate issued for a commercial vehicle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.2(1), and
13 weighing 26,001 pounds or more, must bear the word "commercial," unless the plate is
14 a special registration plate authorized in G.S. 20-79.4 or the commercial vehicle is a
15 trailer or is licensed for 6,000 pounds or less. The plate issued for vehicles licensed for
16 7,000 pounds through 26,000 pounds must bear the word "weighted".

17 A registration plate issued by the Division for a private passenger vehicle or for a
18 private hauler vehicle licensed for 6,000 pounds or less, other than a Friends of the
19 Great Smoky Mountains National Park special registration ~~plate~~-plate, a Blue Ridge
20 Parkway Foundation special registration plate, or a Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation
21 special registration plate shall be a "First in Flight" plate. A "First in Flight" plate shall
22 have the words "First in Flight" printed at the top of the plate above all other letters and
23 numerals. The background of the plate shall depict the Wright Brothers biplane flying
24 over Kitty Hawk Beach, with the plane flying slightly upward and to the right."

25 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to
26 read:

27 "(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration
28 plates:

- 1 ...
- 2 (1a) Alternative Fuel Vehicles. – Issuable to the registered owner of an
- 3 alternative fuel vehicle. The plate shall bear the words "Alternative
- 4 Fuel Vehicle". The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this
- 5 subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate.
- 6 ...
- 7 (3d) Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation. – Issuable to a registered owner of a
- 8 motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall have
- 9 the words "First in Flight" printed at the top of the plate above all other
- 10 letters and numerals. The background of the plate shall be the full art,
- 11 three-color design submitted to the Division by the Blue Ridge
- 12 Parkway Foundation in camera-ready format. The background color
- 13 and design shall allow the numbers on the face of the plate to be
- 14 readily distinguished. Submission to the Division of the background
- 15 design shall be the final design, and, upon acceptance by the Division,
- 16 no further changes in the background design shall be made.
- 17 (3e) Breast Cancer Awareness. – Issuable to the registered owner of a
- 18 motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear
- 19 the phrase "Early Detection Saves Lives" and a representation of a
- 20 pink ribbon. The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
- 21 the plate before it may be developed.
- 22 (~~3d~~)(3f) Bronze Star Recipient. – Issuable to a recipient of the Bronze Star. The
- 23 plate shall bear the emblem of the Bronze Star and the words "Bronze
- 24 Star."
- 25 ...
- 26 (27c) Mothers Against Drunk Driving. – Issuable to the registered owner of
- 27 a motor vehicle. The plate shall bear the letters "M.A.D.D." and the
- 28 words "Mothers Against Drunk Driving". The Division must receive
- 29 300 or more applications for the plate before it may be developed.
- 30 ...
- 31 (36b) Retired Law Enforcement Officers. – Issuable to a retired law
- 32 enforcement officer presenting to the Division, along with the
- 33 application for the plate, a copy of the officer's retired identification
- 34 card or letter of retirement. The plate shall bear the phrase "Retired
- 35 Law Enforcement Officer" and representation of a law enforcement
- 36 badge. The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this
- 37 subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate.
- 38 (~~36b~~)(36c) Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation. – Issuable to the registered owner of
- 39 a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear
- 40 the phrase "Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation" and a logo approved by
- 41 the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation, Inc.
- 42 (~~36e~~)(36d) Save the Sea Turtles. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor
- 43 vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate may bear the

phrase "Save the Sea Turtles" and a representation related to sea turtles.

...

(45b) Surveyor Plate. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the words "Following In Their Footsteps" and shall bear a picture of a transit.

~~(45b)~~(45c) Sweet Potato. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle. The plate may bear a phrase and picture representing the State's official vegetable, the sweet potato. The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate.

~~(45e)~~(45d) Tobacco Heritage. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle. The plate shall bear a picture of a tobacco leaf and plow. The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate.

(52) Zeta Phi Beta Sorority. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the words "Zeta Phi Beta" and the sorority's symbol."

SECTION 3. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates, including additional Congressional Medal of Honor, 100% Disabled Veteran, and Ex-Prisoner of War plates, are subject to the regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

SECTION 4. G.S. 20-79.7(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), and the Natural Heritage Trust Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, as follows:

22 **SECTION 5.** G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding two new subdivisions to
23 read:

24 "(b25) Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation. – The Division must receive 300 or more
25 applications for a Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation plate before the plate may be
26 developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and
27 Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Blue Ridge Parkway
28 Foundation plates to the Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation for use in promoting and
29 preserving the Blue Ridge Parkway as a scenic attraction in North Carolina.

30 (b26) Surveyor Plate. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for a
31 Surveyor plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly
32 the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale
33 of Surveyor plates to the North Carolina Society of Surveyors Education Foundation,
34 Inc., for public educational programs.

35 (b27) Zeta Phi Beta Sorority – The Division must receive 300 or more applications
36 for a Zeta Phi Beta sorority plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall
37 transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account
38 derived from the sale of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority plates to the Zeta Phi Beta Sorority
39 Education Foundation, through the Raleigh office, for the benefit of undergraduate
40 scholarships in this State."

41 **SECTION 6.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
