2	AN ACT MODIFYING THE DEFINITION OF "RESTAURANT" FOR ABC
3	PERMITS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 18B-1000 reads as rewritten:
6	"§ 18B-1000. Definitions concerning establishments.
7	The following requirements and definitions shall apply to this Chapter:
8	
9	(6) Restaurant. – An establishment substantially engaged in the business
10	of preparing and serving meals. To qualify as a restaurant, an
11	establishment's gross receipts from food and nonalcoholic beverages
12	shall be not less than forty percent (40%)-thirty percent (30%) of the
13	total gross receipts from food, nonalcoholic beverages, and alcoholic
14	beverages. A restaurant shall also have a kitchen and an inside dining
15	area with seating for at least 36 people."
16	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
