drivers license revoked for a period of two years. Upon a first conviction only	ly for a
violation of subsection (a) of this section, a trial judge may allow limited	driving
privileges in the manner set forth in G.S. 20-16.1(b)."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2003, and ap	plies to
offenses committed on or after that date. Prosecutions for offenses committed be	fore the
effective date of this act are not abated or affected by this act, and the statu	tes that

would be applicable but for this act remain applicable to those prosecutions.
