AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE OFFICE OF CORONER IN JOHNSTON COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The office of coroner in Johnston County is abolished. **SECTION 2.** Chapter 152 of the General Statutes is not applicable to Johnston County.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law. In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 24th day of June, 2004.
