"(b) All applicants for licensure or apprentice designation sh	hall consent to a

12 (b) All applicants for licensure or apprentice designation shall consent to a 13 criminal history record check. Refusal to consent to a criminal history record check may constitute grounds for the Board to deny licensure or apprentice designation to an 14 15 applicant. The Board shall ensure that the State and national criminal history of an applicant is checked. The Board shall be responsible for providing to the North Carolina 16 Department of Justice the fingerprints of the applicant to be checked, a form signed by 17 the applicant consenting to the criminal record check and the use of fingerprints and 18 other identifying information required by the State or National Repositories of Criminal 19 Histories, and any additional information required by the Department of Justice. The 20 21 Board shall keep all information obtained pursuant to this section confidential. The Board shall collect any fees required by the Department of Justice and shall remit the 22 fees to the Department of Justice for expenses associated with conducting the criminal 23 history record check." 24 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 25
