SENATE BILL 1265

Short Title: Orange Campus Precincts. (Local)

Sponsors: Senator Kinnaird.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT ALL CAMPUS RESIDENCES IN ORANGE
COUNTY FOR EACH UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA SYSTEM
CAMPUS BE IN ONE PRECINCT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Article 12 of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes is amended
by adding a new section to read:

**"§ 163-130.3. Precincts for on-campus resident students at The University of
North Carolina.**

(a) Each county board of elections in any county in which a constituent
institution of The University of North Carolina is located shall reconfigure its precinct
boundary lines by June 30, 2005, in order to achieve the purpose stated in subsection (b)
of this section.

(b) For each campus of a constituent institution of The University of North
Carolina, all residence facilities in which enrolled students are housed on a regular basis
in the same county shall be located in one precinct for voting purposes."

SECTION 2. This act applies to Orange County only.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
