1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO MAKE A CONFORMING STATUTORY CHANGE CONCERNING 3 THE ORGANIZATIONAL SESSION IF THE SESSION LIMITS 4 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT IS APPROVED BY THE VOTERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 120-11.1 reads as rewritten:

"§ 120-11.1. Time of meeting.

The regular session of the Senate and House of Representatives shall be held biennially beginning at 12:00 noon on the third Wednesday after the second Monday in January first Wednesday in December next after their election."

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall take effect only upon approval of the voters of the constitutional amendments set forth in Sections 1 and 2 of Senate Bill 3, 2003 Session, AN ACT TO AMEND THE NORTH CAROLINA CONSTITUTION TO LIMIT THE LENGTH OF LEGISLATIVE SESSION, AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EARLIER CONVENING TIME FOR ORGANIZATION. If the constitutional amendments proposed in Sections 1 and 2 of that act are approved by the voters, Section 1 of this act shall become effective at the same time as the constitutional amendments.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
