SECTION 1. Article 12 of Chapter 106 of the General Statutes is amend by adding a new section to read: "§ 106-124.1. Civil penalties.	.ed
(a) The Commissioner may assess a civil penalty of not more than two thousa dollars (\$2,000) against any person who violates a provision of this Article or any repromulgated thereunder. In determining the amount of the penalty, the Commission shall consider the degree and extent of harm caused by the violation. No penalty shall assessed unless the person has been given written notice of the violation and has be given a reasonable period of time in which to correct the violation; provided that person shall not be entitled to a period of time to correct a violation before a penalty assessed when the violation is likely to cause physical injury or illness. (b) Training and management practices implemented for the purpose complying with this Article shall be a mitigating factor in the assessment of a circular circ	be en t a of
