11	<u>(7)</u>	Commits an assault with a deadly weapon or an assault that	inflicts
12		serious injury on a person with whom he or she has a p	<u>ersonal</u>
13		relationship in the presence of a minor who is residing with or	<u>r in the</u>

15		in this subdivision:	
16		<u>a.</u> "In the presence of a minor" means:	
17		<u>1.</u> <u>In the physical presence of the minor; or </u>	
18		2. Having knowledge that a child is present and may	see or
