1	A JOINT RESOLUTION HONORING THE LIFE AND MEMORY OF PAUL P.
2	HARRIS AND THE FOUNDERS OF ROTARY INTERNATIONAL ON THE
3	ORGANIZATION'S ONE HUNDREDTH ANNIVERSARY.
4	Whereas, on February 23, 1905, a group of friends led by Paul P. Harris met
5	in Chicago to establish a professional club in their community; and
6	Whereas, because the early meetings of this group rotated among the
7	businesses in the area, the name "Rotary" was chosen for this newly formed
8	organization; and
9	Whereas, the popularity of Rotary increased, and clubs quickly formed
10	throughout the United States and around the world; and
11	Whereas, in 1922, the name Rotary International was adopted; and
12	Whereas, Paul P. Harris died on January 27, 1947, at the age of 79; and
13	Whereas, today, more than 1.2 million business and professional leaders
14	belong to over 31,000 Rotary clubs in 166 countries worldwide; and
15	Whereas, for 100 years, Rotary members have been committed to serving
16	their communities by participating in projects that address important issues such as
17	illiteracy, poverty, hunger, children-at-risk, career development, and global health
18	concerns; and
19	Whereas, Rotary clubs are nonpolitical, nonreligious, and open to all cultures,
20	races, and creeds; and
21	Whereas, the existence of Rotary has made a tremendous difference in the
22	communities in which we live; Now, therefore,
23	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:
24	<b>SECTION 1.</b> The General Assembly honors the life and memory of Paul P.
25	Harris and the founders of Rotary International for their role in establishing the world's
26	first service organization.
27	<b>SECTION 2.</b> The General Assembly congratulates Rotary International on
28	its 100 <sup>th</sup> anniversary and commends the organization for its continued service around
29	the world.

SECTION 3. The Secretary of State shall transmit a certified copy of this
resolution to the president of Rotary International.

3 **SECTION 4.** This resolution is effective upon ratification.
