A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HUNTING ON THE PROPERTY OF ANOTHER
2 WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION IN WILSON COUNTY.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** It is unlawful to hunt on the land of another without having on
6 one's person while hunting the written permission, signed and dated for the current
7 hunting season, of the landowner or lessee, or the landowner's or lessee's designee.

8 **SECTION 2.** Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor for the first
9 offense and a Class 2 misdemeanor for a second or subsequent offense.

10 **SECTION 3.** This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the
11 Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by peace officers
12 with general subject matter jurisdiction.

13 **SECTION 4.** This act applies only to Wilson County.

14 **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2005, and applies to
15 offenses committed on or after that date.
