A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO REDUCE THE REQUIREMENT SO THAT ONE HUNDRED FIFTY 3 APPLICATIONS NEED TO BE RECEIVED BEFORE THE DIVISION OF 4 MOTOR VEHICLES MAY ISSUE A COUNTY COMMISSIONER SPECIAL 5 REGISTRATION PLATE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-79.4(b)(11) reads as rewritten: 8 "(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration 9 plates: 10 11 (11)County Commissioner. - Issuable to a county commissioner of a county in this State. The plate shall bear the words "County 12 followed first by a number representing the 13 Commissioner" 14 commissioner's county and then by a letter or number that distinguishes plates issued to county commissioners of the same 15 16 county. The number of a county shall be the order of the county in an 17 alphabetical list of counties that assigns number one to the first county in the list and a letter or number to distinguish different cars owned by 18 the county commissioners in that county. The Division may not issue 19 20 the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300
