5	SECTION 1. Article 14 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by					
6	6 adding a new section to read:					
7	7 " <u>§ 14-56.4. Breaking or entering a building that is a place of worship.</u>					
8	(a) Any person who wrongfully breaks or enters any building that is a place of					
9	worship is guilty of a Class G felony except as provided by subsection (b) of this					
10	section.					
11	(b) <u>A person is guilty of a Class F felony, if:</u>					
12	(1) The person breaks or enters two or more buildings that are places of					
13	worship; or					
14	(2) The person is convicted of a second or subsequent violation of					
15	subsection (a) of this section.					
16	(c) As used in this section, a "building that is a place of worship" shall be					
17	construed to include any church, chapel, meetinghouse, synagogue, temple, or mosque."					
18	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2005, and applies to					
19	offenses committed on or after that date.
