A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO
2 INCREASE THE NUMBER OF DNA CRIME LAB INVESTIGATORS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
6 Department of Justice the sum of one hundred sixty-six thousand six hundred fifteen
7 dollars (\$166,615) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of four hundred sixty-eight
8 thousand ninety-seven dollars (\$468,097) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to fund seven
9 new DNA investigators to expedite DNA analysis and speed the review, auditing, and
10 uploading of DNA profiles into the DNA database (CODIS).

11 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
