A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT ALLOWING MUNICIPALITIES, COUNTIES, AND OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OF THE STATE TO RETAIN BIDS FROM THE FIRST 3 4 ADVERTISEMENT WHEN THE MINIMUM NUMBER WAS NOT RECEIVED. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 143-132(a) reads as rewritten: 6 7 No contract to which G.S. 143-129 applies for construction or repairs shall be "(a) 8 awarded by any board or governing body of the State, or any subdivision thereof, unless at least three competitive bids have been received from reputable and qualified 9 contractors regularly engaged in their respective lines of endeavor; however, this section 10 shall not apply to contracts which are negotiated as provided for in G.S. 143-129. 11 Provided that if after advertisement for bids as required by G.S. 143-129, not as many as 12 three competitive bids have been received from reputable and qualified contractors 13 14 regularly engaged in their respective lines of endeavor, said board or governing body of the State agency or of a county, city, town or other subdivision of the State shall again 15 advertise for bids; and ifbids. If the board or governing body advertises for bids using 16 the bid documents from the first advertisement, the board or governing body shall retain 17 all bids submitted as a result of the first advertisement, and they shall be opened after 18 the receipt of bids from the second advertisement only if the bidder has notified the 19 board or governing body in writing that the bidder continues to want to bid on the 20 contract. If, as a result of such-the second advertisement, not as many as three 21 22 competitive bids from reputable and qualified contractors are received, such-including bids retained from the first advertisement, the board or governing body may then let the 23 contract to the lowest responsible bidder submitting a bid for such the project, even 24 25 though only one bid is received." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 26
