(3) 5 (4) Hospital, nursing home, rest home, and State facility operated under 6 the authority of G.S. 122C-181. 7 Local health department and local department of social (5) 8 services and the building and grounds where the local health department or local department of social services, as applicable, is 9 located. For purposes of this subdivision, "grounds" means a 50-foot 10 11 area surrounding the building entrances and exits and a 50-foot area surrounding all air intake vents for the building ventilation system. 12 Any nonprofit organization or corporation whose primary purpose is to 13 (6) 14 discourage the use of tobacco products by the general public.
