Whereas, the Constitution states that the State Board of Education shall	
consist of the Lieutenant Governor, the Treasurer, and 11 members appointed by the	
Governor, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly in joint session; and	
Whereas, the Constitution directs the General Assembly to divide the State	
into eight educational districts; and	
Whereas, the Constitution further directs the Governor to appoint one	
member of the State Board of Education from each of the eight educational districts and	
three members from the State at large; and	
W	Thereas, the General Assembly has not reconfigured the eight educational
districts since 1945; Now, therefore,	
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-65 reads as rewritten:	
"8 115C-65 State divided into districts "	

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
