1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO MODIFY THE AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SECRETARY OF
3	TRANSPORTATION TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM THE HIGHWAY TRUST
4	FUND AND TO PROVIDE A FORMULA FOR TRANSFER OF FUNDS TO
5	MEET NEEDS BASED ON POPULATION OR CONGESTION AND TO REVISE
6	THE HIGHWAY TRUST FUND ALLOCATION FORMULA.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 136-176(b1) reads as rewritten:
9	"(b1) The Secretary may authorize the transfer of funds allocated under
10	subdivisions (1) through (4) of subsection (b) of this section to other projects that are
11	ready to be let and were to be funded from allocations to those subdivisions.
12	subdivisions and to projects for congestion mitigation. The Secretary shall ensure that
13	any funds transferred pursuant to this subsection are repaid promptly and in any event in
14	no more than four years. The Secretary shall certify, prior to making any transfer
15	pursuant to this subsection, that the transfer will not affect the delivery schedule of
16	Highway Trust Fund projects in the current Transportation Improvement Program. No
17	transfers shall be allowed that do not conform to the applicable provisions of the equity
18	formula for distribution of funds, G.S. 136-17.2A.
19	Transfers made for the purpose of mitigating or reducing congestion shall be made
20	on the basis of either:
21	(1) The ratio that the population the county or counties in which the
22	project is located bears to the total State population.
23	(2) The need for reducing congestion on a roadway based on statewide
24	ranking of projects determined by taking the average daily volume of
25	vehicles divided by the design capacity and then multiplied by the
26	accident rate of the facility divided by the statewide average accident
27	rate for facilities of this type [(Volume/Capacity) x (Accident rate of
28	facility/statewide average accident rates for facilities of this type)].

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1	The Secretary shall adjust the transfer of funds to make up for excess transfers that
2	were previously done to attempt to promptly repay transfers made for purposes other
3	than congestion mitigation.
4	If the Secretary authorizes a transfer pursuant to this subsection, the Secretary shall
5	report that decision to the next regularly scheduled meetings of the Joint Legislative
6	Commission on Governmental Operations, the Joint Legislative Transportation
7	Oversight Committee, and to the Fiscal Research Division."
8	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 136-17.2A(b) reads as rewritten:
9	"(b) Until ninety percent (90%) of the mileage of the Intrastate System projects
10	listed in G.S. 136-179 is completed, the Secretary of Transportation shall, on or before
11	October 1 of each year, calculate the estimated amount of funds subject to this section
12	that will be available for the next seven program years beginning that October 1. The
13	Secretary shall then calculate a tentative percentage share for each distribution region by
14	multiplying the total estimated amount by a factor that is based:
15	(1) Twenty five percent (25%) Fifty percent (50%) on the estimated
16	number of miles to complete the Intrastate System projects in that
17	distribution region compared to the estimated number of miles to
18	complete the total Intrastate System; vehicle miles driven in that
19	distribution region compared to the total vehicle miles driven in the
20	State.
21	(2) Fifty percent (50%) Twenty-five percent (25%) on the estimated
22	population of the distribution region compared to the total estimated
23	population of the State; and
24	(3) Twenty-five percent (25%) on the fraction one seventh, which
25	provides an equal share based on the number of distribution regions.
26	need for reducing congestion on a roadway based on statewide ranking
27	of projects determined by taking the average daily volume of vehicles
28	divided by the design capacity and then multiplied by the accident rate
29	of the facility divided by the statewide average accident rate for
30	facilities of this type [(Volume/Capacity) x (Accident rate of
31	facility/statewide average accident rates for facilities of this type)]."
32	<b>SECTION 3.</b> G.S. 136-17.2A(c) reads as rewritten:
33	"(c) When ninety percent (90%) of the mileage of the Intrastate System projects
34	listed in G.S. 136-179 is completed, the Secretary of Transportation shall, on or before
35	October 1 of each year, calculate the estimated amount of funds subject to this section
36	that will be available for the next seven program years beginning that October 1. The
37	Secretary shall then calculate a tentative percentage share for each distribution region by
38	multiplying the total estimated amount by a factor that is based:
39	(1) Sixty-six percent (66%) Fifty percent (50%) on the estimated
40	population of the distribution region compared to the total estimated
41	population of the State; and
42	(2) Thirty four percent (34%) Fifty percent (50%) on the fraction
43	one seventh, which provides an equal share based on the number of

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1	distribution regions.of the miles driven in the distribution region
2	compared to the total vehicle miles driven in the State."
3	SECTION 4. G.S. 136-17.2A(d) is repealed.
4	SECTION 5. G.S. 136-17.2A(f) is repealed.
5	SECTION 6. G.S. 136-17.2A(h) is repealed.
6	<b>SECTION 7.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
