## **SECTION 1.**

**SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judge for District 30 authorized by this act, and that judge's successor shall be elected in the 2008 election for a four-year term commencing on the first Monday in December 2008.

**SECTION 3.** G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

**SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of eighty-nine thousand one hundred seventy-two dollars (\$89,172) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the additional district court judgeship for District Court District 30 authorized by this act.

 **SECTION 5.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of eighty-four thousand six hundred ninety-six dollars (\$84,696) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the additional assistant district attorney position for Prosecutorial District 30 authorized by this act.

**SECTION 6.** Sections 1 and 2 of this act become effective December 15, 2006. The remainder of this act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
