3 DISTRICT COURT JUDGE AND AN ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT DISTRICT
4 ATTORNEY IN DISTRICT 30.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 **"§ 7A-133. Numbers of judges by districts; numbers of magistrates and additional
8 seats of court, by counties.**

9 (a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the

42 **SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judge
43 for District 30 authorized by this act, and that judge's successor shall be elected in the
44 2008 election for a four-year term commencing on the first Monday in December 2008.

1 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:
 2 "(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each
 3 district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth
 4 in the following table:

17 **SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
 18 Department the sum of eighty-nine thousand one hundred seventy-two dollars (\$89,172)
 19 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the additional district court judgeship for
 20 District Court District 30 authorized by this act.

21 **SECTION 5.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
 22 Department the sum of eighty-four thousand six hundred ninety-six dollars (\$84,696)
 23 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the additional assistant district attorney
 24 position for Prosecutorial District 30 authorized by this act.

25 **SECTION 6.** Sections 1 and 2 of this act become effective December 15,
 26 2006. The remainder of this act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
