A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF PUBLIC HEALTH, FOR INITIATIVES TO PREVENT THE OCCURRENCE OF CHILD MALTREATMENT.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year. These funds shall be used for one position and support costs to coordinate the implementation of NC Institute of Medicine recommendations for initiatives to prevent the occurrence of child maltreatment.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
