A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL TO  
2 REPEAL TERM LIMITS FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 **SECTION 1.** Section 2.1 of the Charter of the Town of Chapel Hill, being  
5 Chapter 473 of the 1975 Session Laws, as rewritten by Section 6 of Chapter 911 of the  
6 1981 Session laws, reads as rewritten:

8 "(c) The mayor shall be elected at biennial elections for a term of two years  
9 subject to the provisions of Section 2.3 of this Charter. ~~No person shall be eligible to be  
10 elected to mayor for more than four successive two-year terms.~~"

11 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
