A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE
CONCERNING THE CIVIL SERVICE BOARD FOR THE CITY OF
CHARLOTTE.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Section 4.61(a) of the Charter of the City of Charlotte, being 7 S.L. 2000-26, as amended, reads as rewritten:

8 "Section 4.61. Civil service Board; Membership, Powers and Duties. (a) 9 Establishment. There is hereby continued established a civil service Board for the City 10 of Charlotte, to consist of five members and two alternates; three members and one 11 alternate to seven members, four members to be appointed by the Council and two members and one alternate three members to be appointed by the Mayor. Each member 12 13 shall serve for a term of three years. In case of a vacancy on the Board, the Council or 14 the Mayor, as the case may be, shall fill such vacancy for the unexpired term of said member. For the purposes of establishing a quorum of the Board, any combination of 15 Board members and alternates totaling a total of three members shall constitute a 16 17 quorum. All Board members and alternates shall attend regular meetings for the 18 purposes of meeting attendance policy and familiarity with Board business and procedures. Alternates shall attend hearings when needed due to scheduling conflicts of 19 20 regular Board members and shall vote only when serving in the absence of a regular Board member. Attendance at meetings and continued service on the Board shall be 21 governed by the attendance policies established by the Council. Vacancies resulting 22 23 from a member's failure to attend the required number of meetings or hearings shall be 24 filled as provided herein. 25 Those individuals appointed by either the Council or the Mayor prior to January 1, 2007, to serve as alternates to the Civil Service Board shall automatically become 26 members of the Civil Service Board for the remainder of their unexpired terms as 27

28 <u>alternates.</u>"

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 2007.
