7	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-499.1 reads as rewritten:			
8	"§ 115C-499.1.	Definitions.		
9	9 The following definitions apply to this Article:			
10	(1)	Academic year. – A period of time in which a student is expected to		
11		complete the equivalent of at least two semesters' or three quarters'		
12		academic work.		
13	(2)	Authority The State Education Assistance Authority created by		
14		Article 23 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes.		
15	(3)	Eligible postsecondary institution. – A school that is:		
16		a. A constituent institution of The University of North Carolina as		
17		defined in G.S. 116-2(4);		
18		b. A community college as defined in G.S. 115D-2(2); or		
19		c. A nonpublic postsecondary institution as defined in		
20		G.S. 116-22(1) or 116-43.5(a)(1).		
21		d. A postsecondary institution owned or operated by a hospital		
22		authority as defined in G.S. 131E-15.		
23	(4)	Matriculated status Being recognized as a student in a defined		
24		program of study leading to a degree, diploma, or certificate at an		
25		eligible postsecondary institution.		
26	(5)	Scholarship. – A scholarship for education awarded under this Article.		
27	(6)	Title IV. – Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended,		
28		20 U.S.C. § 1070, et seq."		
29	SECT	TION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
