A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW RESIDENTS OF OTHER COUNTIES OR STATES WHO
ATTENDED CHEROKEE COUNTY SCHOOLS IN THE 2005-2006 YEAR TO
CONTINUE ATTENDANCE WITHOUT PAYMENT OF TUITION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Any student who was not a resident of Cherokee County but
attended the Cherokee County schools during the 2005-2006 school year may continue
to attend without payment of tuition as long as that student is otherwise eligible to
attend.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
