1 AN ACT TO PREVENT A PERSON WHO IS GUILTY OF PASSING A STOPPED
2 SCHOOL BUS FROM RECEIVING A PRAYER FOR JUDGMENT

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-217(e) reads as rewritten:

7 "(e) Except as provided in subsection (g) of this section, any person violating this
8 section shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. A person who violates subsection (a)
9 of this section shall not receive a prayer for judgment continued under any
10 circumstances."

11 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective September 1, 2006, and applies to
12 offenses committed on or after that date.
