13 14 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred fifty-three thousand dollars (\$153,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred fifty-three thousand dollars (\$153,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be used by Division TEACCH Administration and Research at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. These funds shall be used to support a staff position that will be responsible for researching and capitalizing on new public funding opportunities to support research and program development for the TEACCH Autism Program.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
