**SECTION 1.** G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

## "§ 7A-133. Numbers of judges by districts; numbers of magistrates and additional seats of court, by counties.

**SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judge for District 6A authorized by this act, and that judge's successor shall be elected in the 2008 general election for a four-year term commencing on the first Monday in December 2008.

2	Department the sum of eighty-nine thousand one hundred seventy-two dollars (\$89,172)
3	for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the new district court judge for District Court
4	District 6A authorized by this act.
5	<b>SECTION 4.</b> This act becomes effective December 15, 2006, or the date
6	upon which Section 1 of this act is approved under section 5 of the Voting Rights Act,
7	whichever is later.
