17		SECTION 4.	There is appropriated from the Gener	al Fund to the Judicial

SECTION 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of eighty-nine thousand one hundred seventy-two dollars (\$89,172) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the additional district court judgeship for District Court District 30 authorized by this act.

SECTION 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of eighty-four thousand six hundred ninety-six dollars (\$84,696) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the additional assistant district attorney position for Prosecutorial District 30 authorized by this act.

SECTION 6. Sections 1 and 2 of this act become effective December 15, 2006. The remainder of this act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
