A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO RAISE THE EXCISE TAX ON CIGARETTES AND TO PHASE OUT 3 THE COUNTY SHARE OF MEDICAID COSTS. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 SECTION 1. G.S. 105-113.5 reads as rewritten: "§ 105-113.5. Tax on cigarettes. 6 7 A tax is levied on the sale or possession for sale in this State, by a distributor, of all 8 cigarettes at the rate of two and one half mills three and three-quarters cents (3.75ϕ) per 9 individual cigarette." 10 **SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, 11 effective July 1, 2005, the State shall pay one hundred percent (100%) of the nonfederal 12 share of nonadministrative costs under the Medical Assistance Program for all counties that were designated as enterprise tier one, two, and three for fiscal year 2005. Effective 13 14 July 1, 2006, the State shall pay one hundred percent (100%) of the nonfederal share of nonadministrative costs under the Medical Assistance Program for all counties that were 15 16 designated as enterprise tier counties for fiscal year 2006. Effective July 1, 2007, the 17 State shall pay one hundred percent (100%) of the nonfederal share of nonadministrative costs under the Medical Assistance Program for all counties. For the 18 purposes of this section, "enterprise tier" has the same meaning as under 19 20 G.S. 105-129.2. 21 SECTION 3. Effective July 1, 2007, G.S. 108A-54 reads as rewritten: 22 "§ 108A-54. Authorization of Medical Assistance Program. 23 The Department is authorized and empowered to establish a Medical Assistance Program from federal, State and county federal and State appropriations and to adopt 24 25 rules and regulations under which payments are to be made in accordance with the provisions of this Part. The nonfederal share may be divided between the State and the 26 counties, in a manner consistent with the provisions of the federal Social Security Act, 27 28 except that the share required from the counties may not exceed the share required from the state. If a portion of the nonfederal share is required from the counties, the boards of 29

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- 1 county commissioners of the several counties shall levy, impose and collect the taxes
- 2 required for the special purpose of medical assistance as provided in this Part, in an
- 3 amount sufficient to cover each county's share of such assistance."
- 4 **SECTION 4.** Except as otherwise provided, this act becomes effective 5 July 1, 2005.
