**BILL SUMMARY:** Amends GS 20-79.7(a) to provide that no additional fee will be charged for issuance of the Amateur Radio Operator special plate.

**ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:** As of December 31, 2004 there were 3,363 Amateur Radio Operator special plates. This bill would eliminate the \$10 payment for each plate at a total cost to the Special Registration Plate Account of \$33,630 per year. It is assumed that the number of these special plates stays constant.
