5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
6	SECTION 1. The title of Chapter 115B reads as rewritten:		
7	"Chapter 115B		
8	Tuition and Fee Waivers."		
9	SECTION 2. Chapter 115B of the General Statutes is amended by adding a		
10	new section to read:		
11	" <u>§ 115B-2A. Fee waiver authorized.</u>		
12	The constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina and the community		
13	colleges as defined in G.S. 115D-2(2) shall permit any person to attend classes for up to		
14	six hours of credit or noncredit purposes each academic semester without the required		
15	payment of fees, excluding textbooks, and the Community Colleges technology fee if		
16	the person is a legal resident of North Carolina who has attained the age of 65."		
17	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective August 1, 2007, and applies to		
18	classes for a	ny academic semester beginning on or after that date.
