1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO WAIVE FEES AS WELL AS TUITION FOR CERTAIN PERSONS  
3 ATTENDING CLASSES AT A CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OF THE  
4 UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA OR AT A COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. The title of Chapter 115B of the General Statutes reads as  
7 rewritten:

8 "Chapter 115B.  
9 Tuition and Fee Waivers."

10 SECTION 2. Chapter 115B of the General Statutes is amended by adding a  
11 new section to read:

12 "§ 115B-2A. Fee waiver authorized.

13 The constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina and the community  
14 colleges as defined in G.S. 115D-2(2) shall permit any person to attend classes for up to  
15 six hours of credit or noncredit purposes each academic semester without the required  
16 payment of fees, excluding textbooks and the community colleges technology fee, if the  
17 person has attained the age of 65 and qualifies as a legal resident of North Carolina and  
18 as a resident for tuition purposes in accordance with definitions of residency that may  
19 from time to time be adopted by the Board of Governors and published in the residency  
20 manual of the Board of Governors."

21 SECTION 3. This act becomes effective August 1, 2007, and applies to  
22 classes for any academic semester beginning on or after that date.
